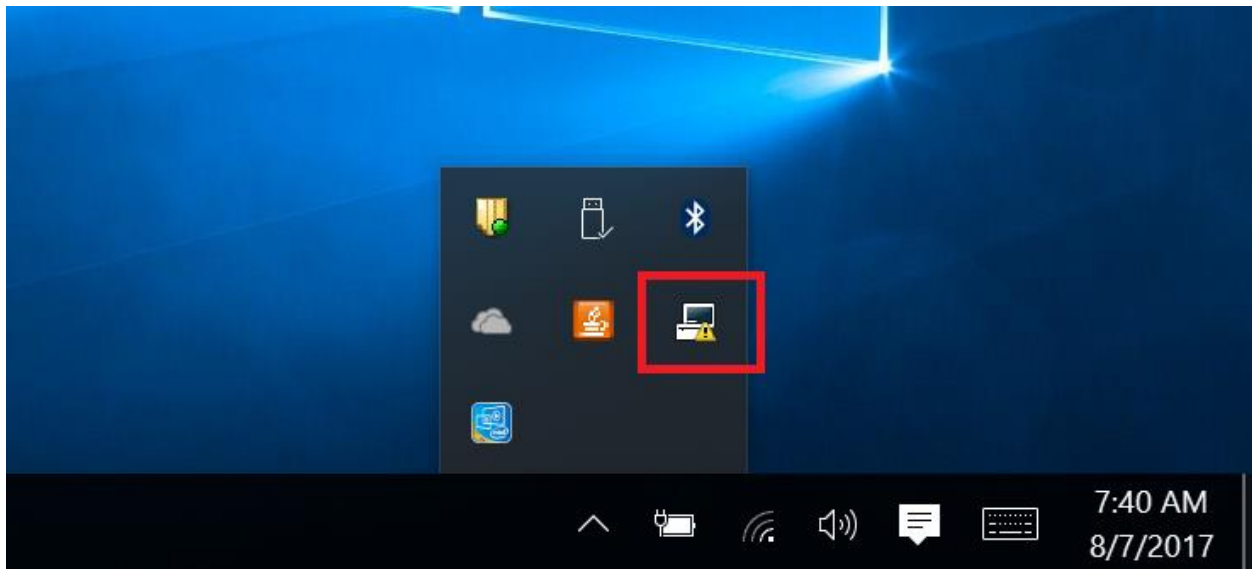
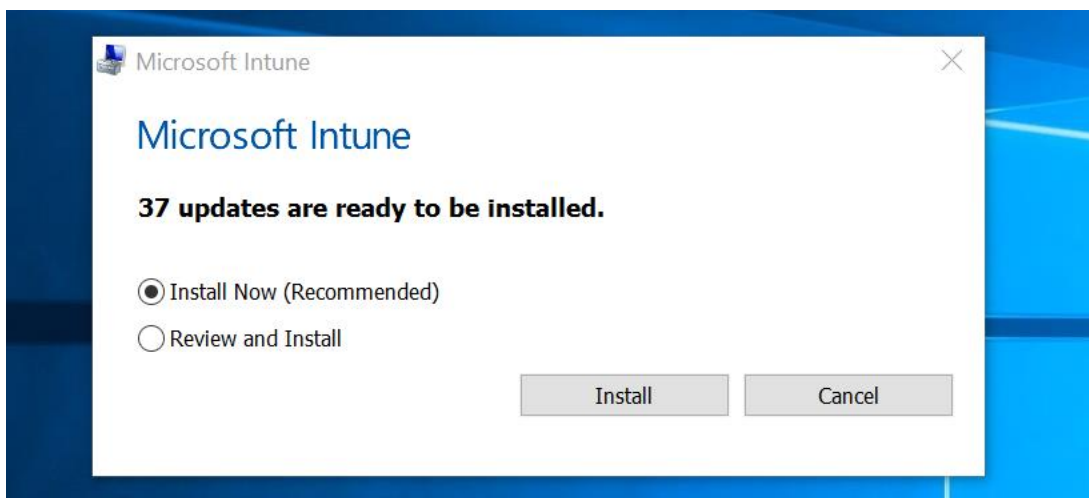


Updating Your Device with Microsoft Intune

- Your device frequently receives updates for improving security, increasing performance, and getting the latest changes to Microsoft applications. Although most updates will be downloaded automatically for you, you will need to regularly restart your device in order for updates to be installed. This guide will show you where to look to see if any updates are ready to be installed. You will also learn how to manually check for updates.
- In the bottom right corner of your screen, click the up arrow and double click on the Intune icon. If the icon has a yellow triangle (like in the below example) then your machine is waiting to install updates and will prompt you to download, install, or restart depending on the status of the updates.



- If your machine has updates ready to install, click the install button.



- If you are unsure if your machine has any pending updates you can manually check by using the Microsoft Intune Center application. Just double click the Intune icon as described above or look for the Microsoft Intune Center program in your applications.
- Once open, just click the Check for Updates button to manually search for updates to your device. If updates are available you will be prompted to install them.
